Acorn Winter squash	Acorn squash has a mild taste that can be easily combined with other flavors bot sweet and savory, similar to the pumpkin but a bit more sugary.
Ageratum Timeless Mix Flower	Short varieties are used as bedding plants. tall varieties make great cut flowers. 'Timeless Mix' is a mix of Ageratum in soft shades of pink, white and blue.
Artichoke	An artichoke is an edible plant with many leaves and a tender, delicious heart. When boiled, artichoke has a mild flavor that can be compared to asparagus
Arugula	Slightly peppery and nutty flavor, edible flowers, great for salads
Asian Eggplant	The inner flesh is cotton white, semi-firm, and nearly seedless. They have a mild and sweet flavor.
Asparagus Crowns	Millennial Asparagus Crowns 4 pack bundle = \$6, Asparagus is a green vegetable that's easily recognizable for its long, pointy spears, which are commonly grilled, steamed, or roasted.
Aunt Molly Ground Cherry	Said to be on of the more sought after and best-tasting cultivars, it has a distinctive sweet flavor reminiscent of tangerines, or as some describe as having "pineapple citrus-like flavor. They are often used in making Ground Cherry pie.
Autumn Beauty Sunflower	Tall, extremely vigorous plants produce beautiful flowers up to 8" across. Bright yellow, bronze, and purple. Edible flowers and good for bee forage.
Bachelor Button Flower	Bachelor's buttons are an old-fashioned favorite with modern-day relevance. Also known as "cornflower", this flower is an abundant producer.
Black Cherry Tomato	These tomatoes are deep red with a blackish hue. The flavor is complex, rich, juicy and sweet.
Bloody Mary Nasturtium	Cream to deep red and every streak and blotch in between~unique and striking! Tropaeolum majus. ... Easy to grow in full to filtered sunlight, it is best to direct-sow in well-draining, loamy soil after the last frost.
Borage Flower	Edible flower with mild cucumber flavor. One of the prettiest of all edible flowers, the blue star-shaped blossoms hold up remarkably well after picking.
Brandywine Heirloom Tomato	i - One of the best tasting tomatoes. We describe Brandywine's luscious, heirloom flavor as "very rich, loud, and distinctively spicy."

Buttercup Kabocha Winter squash	Buttercup squash has a sweet, creamy flavor. Buttercup squash is a lot like kabocha with a belly button — but generally a little larger, a little moister, and not as nuanced in terms of flavor.
Butternut Winter squash	Sweet, moist and nutty tasting, the flavor of the butternut squash is a bit like sweet potatoes.
Calendula Flower	Calendula officinalis is a short-lived aromatic herbaceous perennial, growing to 80 cm (31 in) tall, with sparsely branched lax or erect stems. The leaves are oblong-lanceolate, 5–17 cm (2–7 in) long, hairy on both sides, and with margins entire or occasionally waved or weakly toothed.
Cardoon	Also known as wild artichoke or artichoke thistle, cardoons are hard to find harvested – even at farmers' markets. ... This herbaceous perennial shows off like an extra in Jurassic Park, with silvery leaves and a pearly rib – which is the edible part of the plant, along with the thistle
Chabaud Jeanne Dionis Dianthus Flower	White - Chabaud Jeanne Dionis' has the fullest flowers, boasting ruffled white petticoats of blooms on strong grey-green stems. One of the most fragrant flowers we grow, this old fashioned carnation is best grown as an annual.
Chef's Choice Orange Tomato	i - Chef's Choice is a hybrid tomato variety that was developed from the popular orange heirloom Amana Orange. Its fruit averages 12 oz., have a beautiful orange exterior color and an internal color that is neon orange.
Cherokee Carbon Heirloom Tomato	i - Slice Cherokee purple tomato for rich, dark color and unmatched sweet, rich taste on sandwiches or in salads.
Chives	Chives have a delicate onion flavor that is complemented by hints of garlic.
Choko Pac Choi	Baby pac choi with green stems
Cilantro	An herb used in Asian and Mexican cooking
Collard Greens	They feature dark green leaves and tough stems that need to be removed before eating. The flavor of collards is a cross between cabbage and hearty kale, similar to Swiss chard.
Cornito Rosso Pepper	These peppers have a deliciously sweet flavor. Easy to grow, widely adaptable, and excellent any way you eat them.
Costata Romanesco ribbed zucchini	This zucchini offers an exquisite summer squash texture and flavor with nut-like notes and a lingering sweet taste.
Country Fair Blend Zinnia	A wide range of colors and tall, robust plants. Colors include red, yellow, orange, purple, pink, white and bi colors. Disease resistant with terrific sun and heat tolerance.

Curly Kale	The bright-green leaves are sometimes curled so tightly it can be hard to chop them. This kind of kale tends to have a bright, peppery flavor that can become quite bitter.
Dark Green Zucchini	Its texture is soft but not mushy and its peel is crunchy and spongy. Taste is a bit of squash, with some floral notes and some sweetness to it.
DeCicco Broccoli	Is an heirloom, old-fashioned kind of Broccoli. All the stems and leaves and everything can and should be eaten.
Delicata Winter squash	Also know as "sweet potato squash" for its brown sugar flavor, Delicata tastes like a cross between fresh corn and pumpkin pie.
Fantasia Sunflower	Tall 4–5' stalks bearing 4–8" perfectly round pollen-free flowers. Annual mix with many colors from white to red
Farao Green Cabbage	Farao is a hybrid green cabbage of the ballhead form, meaning it forms a tight head of dense leaves. The flavor of Farao cabbage plants is mild and peppery. The leaves are thin and tender
Fennel	Has a sweet perfumy, anise-like flavor. Rather than making foods taste like licorice, though, fennel imparts a light , bright spring-like quality to foods.
French Tarragon	One of the four fine herbs used in cooking. Perennial in the PNW, should come back year after year. Leaves have a licorice or anise flavor.
Fresno Czech Black Pepper	Delivers a slightly spicier kick, like a mild Serrano chili, the Fresno pepper has a fruitier, smokier taste. This variety is prolific even in the PNW.
Genovese Basil	The large leaves of the Genovese basil plant are known for their intense flavor. They have a wonderful aroma that will waft into the air at the slightest brush of a hand.
Goddess Sweet Banana Pepper	Sweet banana for pickling or fresh eating. Long, thick-walled, smooth fruits are borne on large plants. ... 8-9" long, the fruits are mild when yellow and moderately sweet when they ripen red.
Gold Medal Heirloom Tomato	i - The yellow with streaks of red makes them very attractive and a gourmet's joy when sliced."
Gold Medal Mix Zinnia	A dahlia flowered variety in a mix of color, zinnia are the happiest summer annuals you can grow. Producing blooms 4-5" across, they will reward you with flowers for your bouquets and vases for a long season of cutting.
Gold Nugget Heirloom Tomato	i - Their sunny yellow skin is thinner than most other cherry tomato varieties, giving them a tender texture. They are juicy with a mild, well-balanced sweet flavor and a low acid content.

Grandero Paste Tomato	(i) - Granadero produces very high yields of uniform, attractive, bright red, 4–5 oz. tomatoes with very good flavor. Thick-walled fruit; ideal for fresh tomato sauces, salsas, and salads.
Grandma's Pick Heirloom Tomato	i - Heirloom flavor with hybrid production, uniformity, and disease resistance. Grandma's Pick has an old time look with attractive, large, squat, pleated fruit averaging 3 ½ inches wide and 1 ¾ inches tall.
Green Zebra Heirloom Tomato	i - Green Zebra is a tomato cultivar with characteristic dark green and yellow stripes. Newer variations blush reddish instead of yellow when ripe. It is more tart (described as 'spicy' and 'zingy') than a regular tomato, and it is an early cultivar.
Gypsy Broccoli	Gypsy' broccoli is a very adaptable variety with a strong root system for summer or autumn crops, with uniform, well-domed heads with a medium-small bead size and medium-sized stem. Large, healthy plants tolerate heat and have some resistance to downy mildew.
Hollyhock Flower	Hollyhocks are annual, biennial, or perennial plants usually taking an erect, unbranched form. The herbage usually has a coating of star-shaped hairs
Hopi red dye Amaranth	Historically used by Native Americans, Hopi Red Dye Amaranth has bright red stems and foliage and tall, scarlet, feathery bracts that beg for attention in display gardens. Its scarlet red leaves add bright color and bite to baby leaf salads and its mature leaves can be cooked in a multitude of ways like Kale or Spinach.
Hungarian Breadseed Poppy	This large podded Eastern European heirloom strain has luminous, ethereal white or pale lavender-pink petals with contrasting dark center blotches and blue-green toothed leaves. The eye-catching flowers are followed by urn-shaped decorative pods full of tasty seeds delicious for cooking and baking.
Inca II Mix African Marigolds	Edible - Inca II Marigolds are sure to become the star attraction of your flower beds! They germinate vigorously, are easy to grow and bloom non-stop through the heat of summer until frost.
Jack Be Little Pumpkin	These edible, palm-sized minis become more uniformly orange as they ripen, are commonly used for individual table setting decorations or decorating small spaces.
Jack O'Lantern	Jack-O-Lantern variety is most common for carving pumpkins.
Jalapeno Pepper	Bright, vegetable, and very green, with a slight level of heat. Roasted Jalapenos peppers are richer, slightly smoky, earth with a good heat.
Jewel Mix Nasturtium	Well-known mix of singles and doubles. These bright, 2" blooms of red, pink, orange, and yellow are held above light green foliage.

Jimmy Nardello Pepper	Perfect for frying, roasting, sauteing, or eating raw in salads, Jimmy Nardello is super sweet with notes of apple.
Lambs Ear	Lamb's Ear is an herbaceous perennial ground cover from the middle east featuring thick, soft, velvety, silver-gray leaves that form a rapidly spreading groundcover. They are evergreen in warmer climates. In summer, tiny, purplish-pink flowers appear that are best removed to enhance the foliage
Lemon Balm	This aromatic member of the mint family has a bright, citrusy taste that brings together the acidity of lemon with subtle hints of mint. Both the stems and fresh leaves of lemon balm have a subtly sweet flavor and can be used in food preparation and medicine
Lemon Basil	Lemon basil has a unique herbal, sweet, and tangy flavor with notes of lemon mixed with anise. In the late summer, the plants also produce lemon-scented, small white flowers that bloom on long, light green bracts.
Lemon Queen Sunflower	Lemon yellow petals surround a dark disk
Mammoth Grey Stripe Sunflower	Classic, Giant Sunflower, 10' plants with 12" heads
Mega Sugar Snap Pea	3' plant with flavorful pods
Mexican Strain Tomatillo	Small, round fruits resembling little tomatoes bearing a papery outer covering. Green tomatillos usually have a slightly tart flavor.
Mint Chocolate	are attractive, fragrant and easy to grow. As with most square-stemmed members of the mint family, growing chocolate mint can take over the area in which it is planted in the ground, readily and quickly
Mrs. Stuart's Poppy	Red Flower - Poppies are flowering plants in the subfamily Papaveroideae of the family Papaveraceae. They produce open single flowers gracefully located on long thin stems, sometimes fluffy with many petals and sometimes smooth.
New England Pie Pumpkin	est variety for pie making or small Jack-O-Lanterns. Although not as sweet as squash, the well-colored, orange flesh is relatively starchy, dry, and stringless.
New Girl Tomato	New Girl is an early variety well worth growing for your first tomatoes of the season. It has outstanding flavour and disease resistance.
Oklahoma Scarlet Zinnia	Brilliant scarlet blooms are held on exceptionally strong stems. Flowers are superb for cutting. Highly disease resistant and attract hummingbirds, butterflies, and beneficial insects.
Omero Red Cabbage	Omero Hybrid Red Cabbage produces short-core, tasty heads with a pleasing texture and good storage qualities. Its deep purple-burgundy color is a welcome addition to slaws and salads.

Oregano	Oregano is a peppery herb that is pungent and sharp with a slightly bitter taste. Its bold flavor works best in bold cuisine, but it can be used to add a wonderful heat and nice flavor to a wide variety of foods.
Parsley	Parsley has a clean and peppery taste with a touch of earthiness, making it a great all-rounder in the kitchen. Running through each leaf is a natural aromatic oil, and it's this which is responsible for its unmistakable flavour.
Patio Baby Eggplant	Loaded with a rich, mild, sweet flavor, are delicious baked, roasted, or sauteed.
Pickling Cucumber	Best variety for pickling.
Princess Mix Aster Flower	A mix of purple, pink, fuchsia, and white quilled or flat double petaled beauties. The Princess Mix Aster is a sophisticated addition to cut flower arrangements or the annual border.
Provider Green Bean	Provider is a dependable green, bush, snap bean with very good flavor. Beans are tender and have a nice crisp crunch. Great eaten pickled, cooked, raw.
QIS™ Formula Mix Gomphrena	This is a compact annual that typically grows 12-24" tall on upright branching stems. The true flowers are insignificant, tiny, white to yellow trumpets that are only visible close up.
Rainbow chard	The bright-green leaves are sometimes curled so tightly it can be hard to chop them. This kind of kale tends to have a bright, peppery flavor that can become quite bitter.
Red Gem Marigolds	Edible - It has lovely lacy leaves and dainty single flowers. The leaves and flowers have a subtle citrus aroma and the flowers are edible.
Red Knight Bell Pepper	Big, blocky, thick-walled bell pepper turns red early. Fruity and sweet. Extremely versatile
Red Kuri Winter squash	When cooked, Red Kuri squash has a smooth and tender texture with a sweet, nutty flavor reminiscent of chestnuts.
Romaine 6- pack Variety Lettuce	Speckled, Green and Red Romaine Varieties
Rosemary	Rosemary is described as a woody, perennial herb that can become a bushy shrub. The leaves are evergreen and needlelike in shape, and they produce the essential oil that gives rosemary its characteristic scent.
Royal Burgundy Bush Bean	Eaten raw, they are dark purple, very juicy and crunchy flavor. They acquire a deep green color when cooked, much more dramatic than most green varieties.

Russell Hybrid Choice Mix Lupine Flower	The Russell Lupine Mix creates a dramatic, colorful statement with tall flower spikes that bloom in a variety of shades. Like all lupines, this mixture is very easy to grow and will quickly become a permanent fixture in your wildflower meadow or garden.
Sage	This herb is sweet and somewhat bitter, with a pine-like flavor and aroma. It's also often described as having eucalyptus and citrus notes. Sage can be used fresh or dried and ground, though as with most herbs, the fresh leave offer considerably more flavor.
SC Sunbow Mix Zinnia	Sunbow Mix zinnia includes blooms in shades of scarlet, golden yellow, pink, rose, purple, orange, and white. Flowers are perfectly formed, and held on long, strong and wiry stems. One of the best zinnias for cut flowers.
Scabiosa Black Knight (mourningbride)	a native of southern Europe, is like a pincushion with flowers up to 3 inches in size and scores of yellow or white stamens. The original flowers had a sweet scent.
Scabiosa Pincushion	Elegant cut flowers on strong, slender stems. Sturdy uniform, annual mix in a wide range of colors. Likes rich, well-drained soil, in the sun
Sensation Mix Cosmos Flower	Large, single flowers with yellow center bloom from midsummer on. Easy to grow. Graceful for backgrounds, borders, and bouquets, with see head that attract birds. Tolerates poor soil and hot, humid conditions.
Shishito Pepper	They have a fresh peppery flavor with a brightness and slightly sweet. Great pan-seared as a side dish
Siletz Tomato	d - Siletz is one of the most reliable slicing tomatoes you can grow. The flavor-packed red tomatoes are nearly seedless. Expect several bursts of ripe tomatoes as the season progresses.
Slicing Cucumber	Slicing" refers to cucumbers sold fresh for immediate consumption. Characterized by thick, uniform, dark green skins, slicing cucumbers are longer than pickling types.
Soraya Sunflower	Classic sunflower, great for cutting. Minimal pollen. Branches are 35–48" with multiple 4–6" blooms
Speckled Roman Paste Tomato	d - Gorgeous 5" long fruits with jagged orange and yellow stripes. Meaty flesh with few seeds. Great tomato taste, ideal for processing and fresh eating.
Spinach	Medium Dark green leaves
Strawberry	Day Neutral - Strawberry is an herbaceous perennial in the family Rosaceae. The plant has a short stem and trifoliate leaves which form a crown. close to the ground.

Strawberry Fields Gomphrena	Red flowers also known as Rio Grande globe amaranth. Their red flowers are reminiscent of a strawberry. It can grow up to 18 inches in height.
Strawflower	Xerochrysum produces showy, papery-like bracts in a variety of colors. Tiny, individual flowers are yellow in color and formed into a large cluster surrounded by beautiful bracts. Xerochrysum is attractive to bees, butterflies and birds. It is one of the most popular everlasting flowers, due to its enduring beauty and a wide color palette.
Striped Italian Eggplant	(Annina spineless purple-striped Italian type) When cooked, Italian eggplants are tender and creamy with a rich flavor. The dark purple skin is more tender and the inside tends to taste sweeter, but still just as meaty.
Sugar Cube Melon	Its interior flesh is tender and juicy with an exceptionally sweet flavor and vivid salmon-orange color. This petite melon is known as a breakfast type melon and will at maturity weigh no more than two pounds.
Sunbright Sunflower	single-stem, pollenless sunflower
Sungold Cherry Tomato	i - Notable for its very sweet taste, this cultivar stays firm longer than other cherry tomato varieties. It has a balance of citrusy tartness and sweetness, with other hints of grape and floral flavors.
Sunrich Orange Sunflower	single-stem, pollenless sunflower
Super Sweet 100 Heirloom Tomato	i - Clusters of deliciously sweet tomatoes high in sugar and vitamin c make these perfect for snacking, salads and even juicing.
Sweet Corn	aka corn on the cob, multi-purpose vegetable; an annual crop with yellow, white, or bi-colored ears
Sweet William Dianthus Flower	sweet William, typically grows 12-24" tall and features small flowers held in dense, flat-topped terminal clusters (3-5" wide). ... Flowers come in vivid shades of red, pink, white and bicolor, sometimes with a contrasting eye, and with fringed petals that are bearded on the inside.
Teddy Bear Sunflower	Dwarf, with a shaggy bloom
Ten Fingers of Naples Paste Tomato	d - Fruits are produced in long trusses, giving them a finger-like appearance. Flavor is sweet, rich and superior to many modern day varieties. Ideal for cooking, canning and preserving.
Thai Basil	Thai basil has anise and licorice like and slightly spicy taste. It is more stable under high or extended cooking temperatures than that of sweet basil.

Thyme	Stems are stiff and woody and leaves are small, oval and gray-green in color. Flowers can be white to lilac and are in small clusters. Thyme is highly aromatic with a hint of clove and mint fragrance.
Tulsi Sacred Basil	This green leafy plant, also known as <i>Ocimum sanctum</i> L. and tulsi, is native to Southeast Asia. It has a history within Indian medicine as a treatment for many conditions, from eye diseases to ringworms. From the leaves to the seed, holy basil is considered a tonic for the body, mind, and spirit.
Tuscan Kale	Tuscan kale goes by many names. ... This kale has longer spear-like leaves with a pebbled appearance and a dark, mottled green color. Its flavor is deep and earthy — it's less bitter than curly leafed, with an almost-nutty sweetness
White Cauliflower	White is the most common colour of cauliflower, though purple, yellow, green, and brown cultivars do exist. Cauliflowers are annual plants that reach about 0.5 metre (1.5 feet) tall and bear large rounded leaves that resemble collards (<i>Brassica oleracea</i> , variety <i>acephala</i>).
Wisconsin 55 Tomato	i - A superb tomato developed at the University of Wisconsin. Large deep red fruits resist shoulder cracks and blossom end rot, ripen evenly and have strong skin and solid flesh
Yellow Squash	Just like green zucchini but a deep yellow. Beautiful, colorful and tasty.
Zinnia Sunbow Mix	A wide range of colors and tall, robust plants. Colors include red, yellow, orange, purple, pink, white and bi colors. Disease resistant with terrific sun and heat tolerance.
